

Our community prepared 172 shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child which will be delivered to needy children around the world; 525 Loot bags were delivered to St. John the Compassionate mission to be distributed to men, women and children in the city; and finally through Prison Ministry Canada Angel Tree Program, 20 children whose parent is imprisoned received Christmas gifts sent on behalf of their parent.
